

Jr. FFA Membership Application

Junior FFA Chapters are for the purpose of enhancing and encouraging the education of younger students who are interested in the agricultural industry. Membership in the Texas Junior FFA organization shall consist of students enrolled in public schools or accredited private schools who are in the third grade and eight years old and may continue until they become eligible to enroll in the Agricultural Science and Technology program. The membership year begins September 1 and ends August 31.

Junior FFA members are not eligible to participate in events in which Texas FFA Association has direct oversight including but not limited to leadership development events, career development events, speaking development events, state FFA rodeo, and agriscience fair. Junior membership activities shall include exhibition of livestock and poultry projects.

- Jr. FFA dues (\$10.00) must be paid in full each year.
- Jr. members are encouraged to attend the monthly FFA meetings and participate in all local FFA activities.
- Membership will be permitted by the Local FFA Advisors in accordance with the guidelines of our Cherokee ISD school policies.
- Parents and Junior Members will follow all guidelines/rules required by HS FFA members in the exhibition of livestock.
- Parents will maintain contact with the FFA Advisors for livestock and poultry entries and deadlines.
- Parents should keep their emails current through the Advisors.
- Because Junior FFA members are not in the high school agriculture classes and Advisors do not have daily access to the Jr members, Parents/Jr Members should be attentive and stay current to all show rules and information.
